### How to build a catapult - Storm The Castle

Make 2 pieces in the shape of V letter. Secure the joint part with rubber bands a couple of times. Attach the legs of the V-shaped pieces to the base square, again using rubber bands. This is the fragile form of catapult structure. Then, make a cross using two sticks and attach the cross to the catapult structure to be the throwing arm.

I figured that dowel rods might make a bigger and stronger catapult, so we decided to do that instead of pencils.

The catapult arm can be as long or thick as you want, so choose a piece of wood for the arm and decide how you want the cup to be; you can build it into the wood by carving into the end so it becomes concaved like a cup, or you can use a paper cup or a small box, then attach it to the arm with nails, thumbtacks, or glue.
